****Arrive on time and dressed in Formal Attire (Absolutely NO JEANS!; Boys: tie required, Girls: appropriate dresses (fingertip length/ no two pieces of any kind/ no backless or low cut tops).****

If you are dressed inappropriately, are not on time (without prior notice), or for any reason seem unable to fulfill the task provided for you; you will be asked to serve in an area separate from the Joy Dance.

This event is not about you! This event is about serving our guests and displaying the love of Jesus!

Position Overviews:

Greeters-

Tasked with greeting each family/car/guest who arrives at the Joy Dance in a happy and helpful tone. Required to talk with caregiver of guest (Parent/driver/friend) and obtain information on a "registration card." Point and show caregiver how the guest is being taken care of (Walking up red carpet/ being crowned/ picture in lobby). Release caregiver to Will and April in lobby at registration desk.

Door Holders-

Tasked with holding a door, a server is required to warmly greet guests as they walk from the red carpet into the lobby and then into the gym. Please smile and say, "hello!" "Welcome!" "Glad you are here." as you serve.

Crowns/Tiaras-

Tasked with making one of the FIRST impressions upon the arriving guest. They will place a crown or tiara on the head of the guest (should they wish) and welcome them to the "Joy Dance." They will also be in charge of pointing them in the correction direction to walk up the red carpet.

Registration Assistants-

Tasked with receiving any extra needed or missed information from the caregiver/parents of our special guests. These people must be able to easily converse with adults and be responsible enough to gather the correct information in a timely fashion. Assistants must also be knowledgeable enough to share the “Special Needs” options and classes that Redemption Church has to offer. (Information is given)

Food Table Assistants-

Tasked with restocking, keeping clean and clear, greeting guests as they approach the Food Table and helping in all general food areas while serving their shift. They report and follow any tasks given by Alicia Doherty or Shanda Lyons.

Candy Table-

Tasked with getting all supplies ready and visually appealing. Once appropriate time begins, they are also tasked with standing by the table; helping guests serve themselves, and asking them about their evening and ‘wishing them a Merry Christmas!.’

Table Hostesses-

Following the lead of the Head Table Host; each Hostess is required to ‘manage’ a table. This will require sitting with, asking to dance, cleaning off empty plates/etc, greeting new guests, holding conversation with the table guests (asking about themselves, Christmas plans, where they attend church, how our church can better assist Special Needs in the community, etc.), and serving the families of those in attendance.

Escort/ Dancer-

Tasked with standing on the Red Carpet line and acting like “Paparrazi.” Must be willing to use phone or light to shine on guests as they ‘walk the carpet.’ An escort must have a servant’s heart, be willing to ‘cheer’ for and clap for guests entering, be appropriately dressed, and actively dance WITH the guests. Each Escort on the Red Carpet will be filed through and placed as a “date” with an arriving guest. They will then escort them down the carpet/ point them to the picture station (potentially taking a picture with the guest), and then escorting them into the dance. (Provide direction to the snack table or straight to the dance floor).
