

Camp Guidelines

- BE ON TIME – one late, makes the whole group late.
- STICK TO THE SCHEDULE. Do not alter it to fit your needs.
- Everyone must attend ALL events. This includes worship times, recreation, curfews, meal times, and all other scheduled events.
- No one goes ANYWHERE alone (bathroom excluded). Use the buddy system. A group that leaves together needs to stay together, unless it is approved by a chaperone.
- ROOMS ARE PRIVATE. Girls rooms are pink. Boys rooms are blue. No purple!
- CAMP COUPLES may show no displays of public affection. This week is for you to focus on the Lord, not each other.
- DO NOT BRING alcohol, tobacco, illegal drugs, fireworks, water guns, roller blades, skateboards, or any kind of weapon.
- SHOES must be worn at all times except during swimming.
- NO short shorts (must be finger tip length), tank tops, inappropriate t-shirts, two-piece bathing suits (full coverage tankinis are allowed), or speedos (for the guys). *The Student Ministry staff reserves the right to determine whether or not an article of clothing is disruptive to the purpose and direction of the camp.*
- NO PRANKS. Pranks can be fun, but often cause problems and distract from the purpose of camp.
- LIGHTS OUT means that all rooms should have their lights turned out and should be quiet. Getting ready for bed (showers, brushing teeth, etc.) should be done BEFORE lights out.
- OLDER YOUTH are expected to look out for and encourage younger youth. Older youth should be looking out for opportunities to help, to share, and to lead younger students.
